REGISTRATION COST

The cost of \$135 per week includes all activity supplies used by your child and two snacks per day (morning and afternoon). Each child is required to bring a healthy lunch to eat at noon.

THE PROGRAM AND STANDARDS

- The primary setting is within a classroom set up, but also within lounge areas and outdoors when weather permitting.
- The children are invited to come dressed modestly and according to each day's weather forecast.
- In line with the traditional schoolhouse concept, all ages (5-12 years) remain together throughout each day's program, providing opportunity for the young to learn from the older, and the older to mentor the younger.
- Camp runs Tuesday to Thursday. Registered children are encouraged to come all 3 days each week that they are registered for.
- Camp is a faith-based program, with each day including Assembly time with prayer and Biblical teaching, as well as Christian standards and teaching integrated into every fun activity.
- The Rules of Conduct is attached to this Registration Form, which needs to be signed and submitted at time of enrolment.

By signing below, the signing applicant is in agreement with everything stated on this Registration Form as well as all details covered in the Rules of Conduct. Registration is on a first come basis, so there is no guarantee that this application will be accepted. A non-refundable deposit of one week (\$135) must be submitted with this form, which will be applied to your child's last week at camp. Fees for other weeks are payable on the Friday prior to your child's registered weeks. Methods of payment include e-transfer and cash.

**MARANATHA SUMMER DAY CAMP
RULES OF CONDUCT**

Making the daily camp program and its activities enjoyable and a very positive experience for all children is a priority at Maranatha Summer Day Camp. To ensure this, we uphold the following rules, which we ask that you review with your child before they start attending Maranatha Summer Day Camp.

1. Parent/Guardian must sign each child in/out and print clearly when filling in the information. Child is not to enter the school until a staff member or volunteer greets him/her at the door and acknowledges the sign-in has been completed. Likewise, when picking up your child, sign them out at the entrance and ensure a staff member or volunteer acknowledges the departure.
2. We hold each child as precious and as an individual worthy of respect at all times from their peers, the staff and volunteers. Therefore, condescending talk (even in joking gesture) will not be tolerated, nor will any other gesture, word or action that demeans the child's value.
3. Should any child become unruly, unmanageable or using foul inappropriate language at either of the programs, the parent will be contacted and asked to come for pick-up immediately. Standard discipline measures are in place, and the children will be fully aware of those measures and expectations at the start of camp. But when violated, the School Administrator or Educator has the authority to instill the following discipline measures: 1) At first offense, the child will be spoken with and questions asked of his/her perspective of what just happened; 2) Repeat offense will warrant isolation from the other children, within Educator or Administrator's view, giving time to reflect on and consider proper response to such circumstances in the future; 3) Before being invited back to the group, a discussion will take place privately between the child and Educator or Administrator, and any necessary apologies made; 4) If the incident warrants it, the Educator or Administrator may mention this to the parent at pick up time. If such incidents happen repeatedly and frequently, a conversation will be held with the parents.
4. Bullying is not tolerated, in effort to keep all children safe and to maintain a positive spirit of camaraderie and Christian love between all children. When conflict arises, the staff will always give ear to both sides so that each individual may defend their position, but should a child repeatedly exhibit bullying tendencies, the parents will be spoken with, and a plan on how to deal with it will be determined between the administrator and the parents.
5. Personal electronic devices are not permitted during camp hours, unless the educator notifies parents in advance that it is required for a particular day's activities. So please keep all such items in the car or at home. We also discourage the bringing of any personal toys or other items, to avoid damage or loss. However, the camp may allow for special items to be shared at specific occasions, for which a note will be sent home well in advance.
6. There is zero tolerance at Maranatha Summer Day Camp for children's use of alcohol, drugs, cigarettes, vape smoking or any other harmful substance while attending the program. Such behaviour will warrant immediate expulsion from the program.
7. The children are required to dress modestly at all times in order to prevent inappropriate distractions, even during hot summer days. Modesty constitutes of inseam shorts at least 3", pant waistline not worn below naval area, no belly tops, girls' skirts are to be worn with shorts underneath, and girls' neckline not revealing. Repeat violation will require child being sent home to change.
8. Maranatha Summer Day Camp operates on the Golden Rule of "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you." - showing respect at all times to every child and adult.
9. Number One rule at Maranatha Summer Day Camp.... Enjoy each day and make it count!
